## The Grey Bruce Community Response Protocol (2011)

outlines the way in which our community works together to provide a community response to sexual assault and domestic violence.

**Victim Safety and Offender Accountability** are the twin pillars that guide all interventions and actions outlined in the Protocol.

The Protocol provides all partners with:

- ✓ A common vision, purpose and principles, to guide actions and interventions with victims and perpetrators of domestic violence and sexual assault
- ✓ A shared understanding of partner roles and responsibilities as part of a community response to domestic violence and sexual assault
- ✓ Procedures on client confidentiality, limits of confidentiality, disclosure of information, and information sharing
- ✓ Strategies to improve service coordination and consistency through joint training and case management procedures
- ✓ System-wide tools to address risk, safety planning, and high risk situations
- ✓ Tools for Protocol evaluation and conflict resolution

We will work towards preventing sexual assault and domestic violence in our community by working consistently, collaboratively and inclusively with justice, social and community services to enhance the safety of victims, hold perpetrators accountable and increase public awareness.
